


Our SEL Device Plan

The South Euclid Lyndhurst Schools remains committed to our District's Core Beliefs, one of which is to ensure that our students are prepared to *"meet the demands of the future..."* With the start of the 2017-18 school year, the SEL schools will have completed another step in their aggressive 24-month technology plan, which included adding interactive whiteboards and sound reinforcement to each classroom. In addition, we have provided Professional Development for our staff so they are trained on how to best use technology for the purpose of teaching and learning. We piloted Google Classroom along with various other educational applications across the district and, we also provided each teacher with a Chromebook for the purpose of advancing technology in the classroom. As we approach the final stages of our technology plan, with the start of the 2017-18 school year, each SEL Arc in grades 2-12 will have access to a Chromebook during the school day. Arc students in grades K-1 will have access to a bank of classroom Chromebooks.



Through the implementation and use of 1:1 devices, in the SEL School District now provides teachers and staff the ability to transform the educational efforts and student learning of the on a regular basis.

A technology rich classroom promotes a number of Research Based Best Practices:

- Educational innovation
- Meaningful student engagement
- An improvement to the quality and quantity of specific and timely feedback
- The ability for educators to more readily differentiate instruction to meet a variety of student needs
- Increased access to resources otherwise not available
- Enhanced opportunities for student collaboration (peer to peer, student to teacher)
- Improved lines of communication between home and school
- The enhanced ability to engage in 21st Century Skills such as critical thinking, creativity, global citizenship, collaboration and problem solving

Ultimately, our 1:1 initiative will allow educators to expose our students to real, relevant, and meaningful instructional experiences so they can ultimately compete locally, nationally and internationally.
