

**Band Boosters

January 10, 2012**

Meeting was called to order at 7:15pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the December meeting were approved.

Treasurer: No report.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): Solo and ensemble is February 4 at Cleveland Height High School. We have 10 students performing solos and five ensembles. Boosters will need to pay \$100 for the ensembles. The pre-contest concert is March 8 at 7pm. March 16-17 is the district contest. Our actual assignment is still to be determined. 8th grade parent meeting is this Thursday at 7pm. March 24 is the junior high solo and ensemble at Memorial.

President (David Frey): There was some discussion of the concession responsibilities for the March 24 solo and ensemble. He shared some notes from last year's concession coordinator with Dabney Conwell and Joan Farmer. A leadership focus group will be held January 18, 7-8pm, in the cafeteria. All Booster members should have received an invitation to participate. He brought up a potential fundraiser with the Lake County Captains. We could purchase tickets for a reduced cost (dependent upon the total number of tickets purchased) and then sell them for the face value of \$9.00. He will pursue this. A date of Tuesday, March 20, was selected for the Spaghetti dinner (dependent upon Barry Hartz's confirmation). Much discussion included start time, possible early bird special, take-out option, pre-ticket sales and advertising. An email will be sent out requesting volunteers for the dinner and for the OMEA on March 24.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): 8th graders are scheduled for uniform fittings February 7-9. All uniforms have been inventoried and she is working on a list of necessary replacement items. She will need volunteers for the fittings. Uniforms will be turned in on Memorial Day for dry-cleaning and maintenance.

Website (Alex Heston): There were 290 visits to the website in December and content is up to date. It was suggested that an FAQ page be developed.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): No report.

Fundraising (Ann Brizee): The spaghetti dinner will cover the winter fundraising. A potential fundraiser for spring would be a plant/mulch sale.
