

Band Boosters
Band Room, Brush High School
June 5, 2012

Meeting was called to order at 7:10pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the May meeting were approved.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): The checkbook balance is \$87,218.84. Band camp fee was discussed and several scenarios were presented. It was decided that the fee will be \$225/student. We have received \$1425 in anonymous donations for band camp scholarships. This is in addition to the \$600 allocated by the Boosters.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): Instruments and personal belongings need to be removed from lockers by June 6. Students are coming in June 8 to spray paint stands, clean lockers, etc. Instruments are being inventoried. June mailing will be sent by the end of this week. Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band and Leadership lists have been posted. Leadership Camp will be July 16. Arcette leaders will be integrated into this process. The Brush Band will participate in the Hudson Parade of Bands on October 6. Pay to participate fee has increased to \$100.

President (David Frey): Band camp scholarship applications have been received and are in review. The Band web page will be hosted by the School District and, currently, there will be no cost to us for that service. Dave introduced the idea of having half-time shows sponsored by local businesses. Grants ranging from \$250-\$5000 are available from Legacy Village; applications are due in September. May apply for funds to purchase a new ladder and carts. Dave will assume responsibility for Tag Day. It will be August 18. He also introduced the possibility of having a student representative attend Booster meetings. Kaylee will discuss it with students at the Leadership Camp.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): New uniforms have arrived and uniform turn in went well. She is still missing two uniforms. There are two pairs of pants that were never hemmed properly and were destroyed. The students will be charged for them.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): Overnight slots for Band Camp are filled. There is still a need for bus chaperones, room inspectors and truck drivers.

Website (Alex Heston): There were 170 hits to the website in May. He is scheduled to have training on the school district software on June 8th. He has requested the domain name of /SELBandBoosters but that has not been confirmed. Migration of home page and band camp page will be first priorities, along with posting the 2012-2013 calendar. He requested that the new domain name be posted on our Facebook page and will leave a note on our current home page for the remainder of June.

Fundraising (Ann Brizee): We'll do a mattress fundraiser on October 20 and may do the Yankee Candle sales closer to the holidays.

Arcettes (Scott Dorey): Kelli Parish is the new advisor for 2012-2013. She will introduce more choreography into the routines and would like more integration with the Band. They have some uniform issues which they're working out. They want to do more fundraising for themselves but moneys will remain the Band account.
