

Band Boosters
Band Room, Brush High School
August 14, 2012

Meeting was called to order at 7:10pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the June 2012 meeting were approved.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): Total funds are \$116,300. He'll meet with the bank to try to get a better interest rate and set up on-line banking.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): There will be rehearsals tomorrow and Friday. Students should be on the field ready to play at 2pm. She's staying an hour late every day for testing. Students can also use that hour for practice time. All music (except Get Ready) must be tested in order to perform. Tag Day is August 18 at 9:30am. Students should report in summer uniform. Convocation is August 21. Details are still to be determined. She indicated that attendance has been a bit of an issue this year. She would appreciate more notice in the event of a conflict, especially with fall sports getting started. The first football game is August 24 at home. Report time is 5:45pm. Uniform inspection is required prior to every game and will take place from 5:30-6:30pm. There are two date changes to the schedule: October 4 @ Normandy (instead of Oct 5) and Oct 18 @ Parma (instead of Oct 19. Report times are unchanged. Fall concert date is still to be determined. Date noted in yellow calendar is incorrect.

President (David Frey): Three anonymous donors contributed toward Band Camp scholarships. We offered 13 scholarships – 12 @ \$150 and 1 @ \$220. Two of the recipients transferred out of the district so those were not funded. Because there were excess funds, one of the \$150 recipients received an additional \$70. He shared some thank you notes from some of the recipients. We are still awaiting a final accounting from Band Camp. Some damage costs are anticipated. He noted that the Boosters sponsored a \$25 Game Stop gift card for the winner of the Band Camp march-off that was held on the last night of Band Camp. The Boosters will do a mattress sale fundraiser and a Yankee Candle fundraiser in the fall. He's looking into involvement at the Pancake Breakfast at Lyndhurst Home Days. Home Days provides all of the supplies and the organization provides man power and gets the profits. There is some overlap with the Home Days Parade, but we may be able to split the commitment with another organization. The Boosters needs a new 2nd Vice President to run Tag Day. We have 37 teams for Tag Day; 24 of those have confirmed drivers, 6 have probable drivers, and the remaining need drivers. He will purchase gift cards for the top teams who bring in the most money. He commended Kelli Parish on her work with the Arcettes at Band Camp. He clarified that moneys raised at Tag Day by the Arcette teams will be credited to the Arcette line item on the band budget.

Arcettes (Kelli Parish): It was clarified that moneys raised at fundraisers go to the general fund not to individual student accounts. The Arcettes would like to have a table at Lyndhurst Home Days to sell glow sticks or bake sale items. She was directed to the appropriate person on the Home Days committee.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): All students (except one) have uniforms. All refits are done and orders are in. Kaylee brought up the idea of having a thinner t-shirt and Hope Fry introduced the possibility of a new logo. Twelve raincoats have broken zippers. Lyndhurst Luggage will do the repairs for \$25/raincoat.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): He's working on filling chaperone slots for the football games. He's got approximately 30 names to work from.

Website (Alex Heston): Content is up to date. He'll post a new calendar with the date changes outlined above.

New Business: Hope Fry will head a contest for design of a new logo. Some of the percussion harnesses are in bad shape and need to be repaired or replaced. We still need a new ladder.
