Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the September 2012 meeting were accepted.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): We have \$95,510 in the checking account. Band Camp costs totaled approximately \$40,000. Dave asked that outstanding payables and receivables be added to the treasurer's report.

Mattress Fundraiser: We had a presentation by a representative from Custom Fundraising Solutions regarding the October 20 Mattress Fundraiser. Proceeds will be put in individual student accounts. If students want spirit wear instead (which is an option from the company), an email from a parent will be required.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): The band is still owed \$4000 from the extra curricular support fund. Homecoming is October 12. Report time is 5pm at Marc's. She reiterated the need for proper clothing under uniforms. Concert bands begin October 29. There will be no seating auditions prior to concert bands starting. She would like to set a date for the band banquet, perhaps some time the week of November 26. She'll ask Ann Brizee to get involved again this year. She'd like to do two band shows next year.

President (David Frey): A new director's podium was purchased and he indicated that the band show in Hudson went well.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): More stringent inspections are paying off; students are taking their uniforms more seriously. She's sold a lot of gloves and spats and a couple of sweatshirts and t-shirts.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): No issues.

Website (Alex Heston): We're averaging 20 hits per week. The count as of September 30 was 831 hits, up from 756 on September 11. He will add the mattress fundraiser flyer to the website.

Fundraising (David Frey for Ann Brizee): Stadium chairs are back-ordered. We will do a pie fundraiser via Market Day for pick up in November. We may do a mulch fundraiser in the spring. The mattress sale is October 20 and we'll do a Yankee Candle fundraiser around the holidays.
