

Band Boosters

April 9, 2013

Meeting was called to order at 7:05pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the March 2013 meeting were accepted.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): Account balance is \$88,396.04. Band pre-payments have amounted to \$975. He's looking for safe investment options that may yield more interest, and the account now has a debit card.

Uniform presentation: A representative from Stamburg Uniforms provided a presentation of the different uniform styles and fabrics. The general cost is \$350-\$400 per uniform depending upon the fabric and difficulty of design. He said we should plan to purchase 15-20% more uniforms than band members. He also talked about the payment options – 50% down as a deposit and then the balance upon delivery, or we could take advantage of a 3% cash discount if the entire order is prepaid.

Director (Kaylee Flynt):

The next concert is May 7 at 7pm. Report time will be 6pm. Auditions will be held next month to determine next year's band placements. The Solo & Ensemble is April 13 at Memorial, and the Memorial/Greenview concert is May 15.

President (David Frey): A retirement party for Barry Hartz will be held May 3 in the cafeteria. The Boosters will contribute \$300 to the cost of that party. He estimated that the Boosters will receive \$4000 from the Brown & Gold. Two styles of percussion harnesses have been ordered. We can return the ones that don't fit. The Band Camp Scholarship letter will be sent as soon as possible. The Band Camp trucks have been reserved and people are beginning to respond to the request for volunteers. The District must run background checks on the overnight volunteers, which can take up to 6 weeks, so it is necessary to have them in place soon.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): She's ordered three hats and one jacket. We need lanyards for Band Camp. Dabney Conwell will call some military recruiters to see if some can be donated. Refits will occur in May and seniors will turn in their uniforms on May 7.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): The next event is the Memorial Day Parade. He is looking for squirtable water bottles to hydrate the students during the parade.

Website (Alex Heston): 51 hits since the last meeting. He'll add the flyer on Barry Hartz's retirement party.

New Business: We need a new laser printer. Kaylee will see if the district can provide one. If not, she may ask for the cost to be split three ways – between the band, orchestra and choir boosters.
