Meeting was called to order at 7:10pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the April 2013 meeting were accepted.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): Explained the re-vamped Treasurer's report. Checking account balance is \$92,404.63. He is still exploring some conservative investments in which to transfer some of our funds to increase interest income. Interest income will go into the uniform fund.

Director (Kaylee Flynt):

She's received some preliminary sketches from Stanbury. May 27 is Memorial Day Parade. Students should meet in front of Regina at 8:30am in full uniforms. All uniforms should be turned in following the parade. Received \$475 from the mattress fundraiser to be put in student accounts and she passed around some information about a fruit fundraiser. Auditions will be held May 28 & 29 and will service as the students' final exam grade. 8th graders received the same audition music. Information for band camp scholarships will go out this week; a small committee is needed to review the applications. We will award three \$150 scholarships. She presented two different percussion harnesses. Motion was made, seconded and approved to purchase the Pearl Harnesses.

President (David Frey): We still need more overnight chaperones for Band Camp.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): Most seniors have already turned in their uniforms. She refit 8 students. She needs to purchase additional garment cleaning bags.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): He has sufficient chaperones for the Parade. He will purchase squeezable water bottles.

Website (Alex Heston): 88 hits last month.

Arcettes (Laurie Manahan): The team for 2013-2014 is set. It will consist of 12 girls, only 3 of whom are returning. Kaylee requested a roster so she can send band camp information.

New Business: Registration will be July 21 from 6-8pm and July 22 (times TBD). Dabney Conwell was able to get 175 lanyards from the Marines and will look into getting more. She also provided information on a fundraiser involving Krispy Kreme donut sales at football games. The donuts are purchased for \$3.50/box and sold for \$7.00/box. She will run this idea past the PTSA to make sure they're ok with us doing that during some games. Our used shoe sale will include spats. Anne Frey will contact the Hilton Garden Inn regarding the band banquet; we still need to set a date. Kaylee has been reviewing the applications for Barry Hartz's position. She would like to have the new hire in place before the last day of school.
