Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the September 2013 meeting were accepted.

<u>Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour)</u>: Account balance is \$116,600. \$60,000 has been invested in a stable, low risk money market fund. There is \$1720 in the Uniform account and the Arcettes have \$1185.

Director

Kaylee Flynt: Friday, October 11, is Senior night. Homecoming Parade is October 18. Jazz Band will begin soon. Trumpets and alto saxophones will have to audition (based on interest). Rehearsals will be one night per week. Concert bands will start after homecoming. The new percussion instructor will come two days per week.

Jake Robinson: 6th grade band is progressing nicely. 5th grade parent night was held. There are 130 students in the 5th grade band and only 15-20 are still without instruments. A before-school 6th grade beginning band club will start soon.

President (David Frey): Motions were made and approved to reconfirm all existing board positions. A motion was made and approved to have the new percussion harnesses donated to the school district. Funding for new uniforms was discussed. The Boosters will contribute an amount as yet to be determined (up to \$20,000), the school district will be asked to fund a portion (hopefully at the \$20,000 level), and we will be looking for \$30,000 in corporate support. He has applied to Legacy for a \$5000 grant. The remainder will come from students. Boosters provided refreshments at the Mentor game and it went well. We will continue to do that for future games. We will not do the mattress fundraiser this year.

The Band Banquet will be November 20. The venue is still to be determined.

There will be a number of Board slots available for the 2013-2014 school year, including President, Recording Secretary, Chaperone chair and Website chair.

<u>Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston):</u> She's done five refits and has had two ruined pieces, neither of which was the fault of the student.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): Only a handful of slots left to fill.

Website (Alex Heston): 178 hits since last month.

<u>Arcettes:</u> They are selling butter braids and pumpkin rolls as a fundraiser. They are looking for a new advisor for next year.

<u>Fundraising:</u> Stadium chairs are being sold for \$45 at football games. Moneys will come in from Brown and Gold. We will probably do Yankee Candle fundraiser again.
