

Band Boosters

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the December 2013 meeting were accepted.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): Checking account balance is about \$22,000. \$6143 is in the Uniform Fund. He suggested that we get students to hand deliver uniform fundraising letters to small businesses.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): The solo and ensemble is January 18 at Cleveland Heights High School and the next concert is March 6. Contest will be March 14-15 at Kenston. She will request that the Wind Ensemble perform on March 14 and the Concert Band perform on March 15. The 8th grade parent meeting will be January 22. February 4, 5 & 6 will be uniform fittings for incoming freshmen. Tentative dates for Band Camp are July 27-August 1. She is planning a visit to Edinborough to tour available accommodations, solidify the dates and discuss the housekeeping staff issues that arose last year. April 5 is the Junior High Solo and Ensemble at Memorial. Only 26 students have participated in the uniform fundraiser to date. She will have a separate meeting on January 30 just to discuss the band uniform fundraising issue. Notice will go out to all parents.

President (Anne Frey for David Frey): We need to establish a deadline for a decision on whether to move forward with the uniform purchase for next year or to postpone and continue our fundraising efforts. There is no update on the Legacy Grant or other funding. The Brown and Gold is March 15. The Boosters need to sell 10 horses and 2 ads, and must provide 4 volunteers. A nominating slate for new Booster positions will be voted on at the May meeting.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): She has volunteers for the freshman fittings. Seniors will turn in their uniforms on March 6, and refits can be done at that time as well.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): We'll need chaperones for the large group event, March 14-15.

Website (Alex Heston): 35 hits last month. He's looking for a webmaster replacement for next year.

Fundraising (Ann Brizee): Spaghetti dinner will be February 21 from 5-8pm. She will reserve the cafeteria from 4-9pm.

Arcettes (Laurie Manahan): They held their banquet and inducted three people into their Leadership Committee. They are developing a positive relationship with the YMCA. They made \$540 with their pastry fundraiser and are planning a bake sale around Valentine's Day. January 21 is a fundraiser at Chipotle. They are also fundraising for new uniforms. They will perform at the January 21, January 30 and February 21 basketball games, and have two upcoming competitions. They will recruit 8th graders for minicamps and try-outs.
