Meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m.

**Minutes (Rhonda Pierce)**: Motion to waive reading of minutes – Rhonda, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Jenn.

**Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour)**: Total checking & investment balance \$35,655.99. Received pay-to-play refund of \$3408.00. Bandcamp cost \$245/student this year. If we do not get pay-to-play kickback next year, we will be running short on funds. Pay-to-play kickback can only be used to offset extracurricular costs, can't put into band boosters funds. Band camp costs likely to go up next year. Need to start thinking about fundraising to bring up our checking account balance.

**Director (Kaylee Flynt)**: October invoice for percussion instructor - \$720 (36 sessions @ \$20/session). Lifetouch sent a check for \$144.01 as a thank you kickback. Winter Concert – December 18<sup>th</sup>. Jazz band will be on Thursdays at 3:15. Marching band shirt orders due 11/14. Honors band 11/14 & 11/15 - will play their faces off all day! Band banquet on November 13<sup>th</sup>.

**President (Neil Bloomberg)**: nothing at this time.

**Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston)**: Collected 25 of the 50 senior uniforms. Did not get all of the senior's lanyards back. We will try to collect the rest of the lanyards at this time.

**Chaperones (Karen Durham)**: 40 parent volunteers, about 16 regular ones. Karen was wondering if we could recognize the volunteers. In the past we have recognized chaperones during the spring concert. Need chaperones for - Contests March 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> for high school at Kenston. We host junior high solo ensemble on March 21<sup>st</sup> & will need lots of volunteers. Ask Dabney Conwell about how to run the concessions.

**Website (Alex Heston)**: We had 196 hits last month and show 344 now, so that's 148 this month. Our counter shows 100 different viewers which is 43 more than last month

**Fundraising (Jodi Kogovsek)**: – We could hold fundraiser at Rummy's with celebrity servers, but Kaylee is worried about how it looks having a band fundraiser at bar. It would be a Saturday night. Jodi will secure a date. We could add in a Chinese auction & 50/50 raffle.

**Arcettes (Laurie Manahan & Kelli Parrish)**: not present.

**Banquet (Anne Frey)**: 184 registrations. Kaylee will present awards. Tag day awards - \$25/1<sup>st</sup> place team, \$15/2<sup>nd</sup> & \$10/3<sup>rd</sup> place.

**Old Business**: \$500 to give out for Uniform Campaign prizes. Each student who raised \$100 got 10 raffle tickets, every extra \$10 = 1 ticket. Anne – motion to award 10 - \$50 bills, 2<sup>nd</sup>, Jodi.

**New Business**: Will have a sample pillow at banquet if people would like to order. If graduating students want to donate their shoes, we will take them. Jen & students will paint over old logo with the new one. Motion to give Jenn \$25 to cover cost of paint – Rhonda, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Elizabeth.
