Indicated by the signatures below, we agree to the following:

- 1. MAC students, girls and boys, are known as MAC Ambassadors.
- MAC Ambassadors will participate in age-appropriate activities that promote academic achievement; college & career readiness; financial literacy; character development and integrity; 21st century skills and competencies; arts and culture; and community service.
- 3. MAC Ambassadors will lead and facilitate schoolwide activities to model positive behaviors and encourage academic achievement among their peers.
- 4. MAC Ambassadors will adhere to the following standards and expectations:
 - a. Strive to be a positive leader and role model among their peers.
 - b. Attend school daily and report to classes on time.
 - c. Participate in MAC Program meetings, activities and exposure experiences/trips.
- 5. MAC Ambassadors are not perfect! However, MAC Ambassadors must demonstrate continuous improvement academically and behaviorally.

Selection as a MAC Ambassador is not guaranteed each year; a new application is required annually. Teacher recommendation is a consideration. Attendance, grades and discipline are also considered. Upon selection, MAC Ambassadors will sign an agreement to adhere to the MAC Ambassador standards and expectations. Failure to comply may result in dismissal from the MAC program. *MAC program meetings, activities, exposure experiences and trips occur before or after school and at times, on weekends; parent permission is required.*

Transportation to and from before or *after-school* meetings must be arranged by the parent: (Please Select) My student will walk to/from MAC Program Meetings before or after school.
