

Brush Band Boosters

April 14, 2015

Band Room, Brush High School

Meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

Minutes (Rhonda Pierce): will present at next meeting.

Treasurer (Kevin Gilmour): total investments -\$30,643.53. Only one person has prepaid band camp. Made about \$600 from solo & ensemble. Haven't gotten report from Tupperware yet. No band pillows left. More can be made, will advertise at concert with a form attached to DVD form.

Director (Brad Allen): Marching band will receive (pending approval) \$25/student attending camp. The form this year will say band camp costs \$275 - \$25(district refund) = \$250 parent cost (approximate numbers at this time). We need to make sure that we have accurate count of meal cards needed if people are coming late. Will get back to us with total number of kids in band next year. May 4th Pops Concert; May 6th 7-8th concert; Jr High contest either May 8th or 9th; May 27th – 5/6 concert. Hosting band show on 9/26.

President (Anne Frey for Neil Bloomberg): Dave – please resend out volunteer letter for band camp. Mr. Williamson mentioned that plans are already being made for food at band show. Who is running food? Band or athletic boosters? We need to know if athletic boosters is planning on taking over and we need to make sure that we get to run this event. Anne will talk to Mike Murphy. In the past we weren't able to use concession area. We could make a lot of money selling Brush band & commemorative band show t-shirts. Send out notes to other bands telling them how much the shirts would be. Jenn will design shirts.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston & Jenn Simmons): fitted 48 freshman. We have 40 seniors leaving. Brad has heard that some freshman who weren't in band this year would like to rejoin, they need to come get fitted for uniforms asap. Need to order 2 new jackets. Need to get uniform from Brandon Parks by 5/4 or it will go on his school fees. All uniforms turned in on Memorial Day. Only collect hats from those not staying in band. Charge will show up on student fees for any student not turning in their uniform. Refits (of piece that doesn't fit) & senior collection on May 4th, will need volunteers. Need an e-mail sent home to have students try on uniforms for refits. New band t-shirts if we order at least 144 they would be \$7.49 each with 3 color ink. Make sure that who we ordered from is not affiliated with district and causes a conflict. Brad will ask Kaylee if all kids will be wearing new logo shirts or using old ones.

Chaperones (Karen Durham): Need chaperones for Memorial Day Parade. Will look at what we used for OMEA & give report at next meeting. For future OMEA we can't mark down items too much, and not mark down pop. Will need 12 volunteers to collect uniforms after parade.

Website (Alex Heston): no report

Fundraising: check out website www.sharemysavings.com to see if it is a worthwhile option.

Old Business: Band-aid fundraiser – buy a box of band-aids for \$5/box & we get \$3. We will make a logo sticker to put on each box. We will order 300 & Jenn will make labels.

New Business: Need to select 1 graduating senior to receive a \$200 Brian Gould scholarship & one current student to receive a \$200 Brian Gould camp scholarship. In future years we will use it for camp scholarships.
