

HOMWORK PLAN

1. Student must spend 1 hour a night on homework. Sunday-Thursday.
 2. The same time should be set aside each night
 3. Students must have a place to do homework with necessary supplies (pens/pencils/paper/highlighters), be monitored by an adult and away from distractions (TV/computer/cell phone)
 4. Students must make use of the plan book to write assignments down.
A parent must be check this book at home.
 5. During this time all papers can be organized in the proper folders and binders. Until students understand how to get organized all folders and binders can come home every night.
 6. The following is how the hour can be divided up:
 - all nightly assignments completed in all subjects
 - plan book check off when assignment is completed
 - review of class notes in all subjects:
 - read out loud
 - rewrite notes
 - highlight notes
 - create a summary of the notes in 3-5 sentences
 - make up sample test questions using the notes*(this process will help students begin to study for the unit test)*
 - papers organized in folders and binders
 - anytime remaining can be spent reading...anything that your student enjoys from the newspaper to the bible.
 7. All materials can be packed up in the backpack and be ready for the student to leave in the morning.
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SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES: Some student may need a few breaks in the hour. For example, after 20 min. a 5 min. break then they return to work.

FAMILY EVENING TIME: By planning your evening all members of the family will have more time to spend on activities they enjoy.

BEDTIME: Students can be expected to be in bed at a reasonable time. When this time is set all electronics should not be available to them (TV/computer/cell phone)
