Dear South Euclid Lyndhurst Families,

It is hard to believe the first semester of the 2015-2016 school year is already coming to a close! Due to features available in Progressbook Parent Access, I'm writing to inform you that the SEL Schools are making some changes in the way report cards are distributed from this time forward. For the remaining reporting periods of this school year, your son or daughter's report card will be accessed via Progressbook Parent Access. Paper report cards will not be sent home for the 2nd quarter report card nor will paper report cards be used for the March and May report cards.

Progressbook Parent Access is the parent portal to information that will assist in helping you to support your student(s). Parents are able to access multiple children's information, including student schedules, attendance, classroom assignments, posting of grades in "real time", as well as interim reports and report cards. Progressbook Parent Access is found under the Parents & Students tab on our district website (www.sel.k12.oh.us).

What should I do if I need help registering in my Progressbook Parent Access account?

Please contact the building that your child attends for registration code information.


What should I do if I don't have access to the internet?

The South Euclid Lyndhurst Public Library has computers with internet access which are available to the public. Students have access to computers in the district libraries, media centers, and in classrooms. We recommend you work with your child's teacher and/or building principal to develop a plan that is best for your family. If you are not able to access report card information via Progressbook Parent Access, please let your child's teacher know and a paper copy will be sent home each grading period.

Since this is our district's first attempt at providing families with an online report card, we ask for your patience while we work out any potential "bugs" when the report cards post in mid-December.

Better utilization of technology is a key goal in the South Euclid Lyndhurst Destination 2018 Strategic Plan. Providing the community with paperless interim reports and report cards is a solid step into the 21st century and a fiscally responsible way to manage our resources.
