DATES AND DEADLINES

Wednesday November 2nd, 2022 at 8:05 am will be the Senior Class Meeting with Jostens to introduce Cap and Gown ordering process.

Starting **Wednesday November 16th** there will be a station in the Principal's Office for students to check for proper spelling of their name to be printed on the diploma. Students will be able to add or remove middle initial or suffix. Students may not use a nickname or a made-up name, their name must appear as it does on their birth certificate or in DASL.

Starting **TUESDAY OCTOBER 4th** there will be a representative from College Now in the building to assist with College Applications, scholarships and FAFSA. You may schedule an appointment with our rep and families through Mrs. Campana.

BE IN THE KNOW

Starting this year, our school will be using a new program called TRANSEO. There is a TON of awesome information about your course history, scholarship opportunities, college application process, etc. To access Transeo, go to our website and under the Parents and Students tab, it is listed under the T's. Your username and password are like all your usernames and passwords for our district, and you should be able to log in under Google.

College Applications – colleges will require you to do the following when applying:

- Provide demographic and personal information – name, address, birthdate, etc.
- Your desired major that you are considering
- Some will require essays – there are usually questions that they will provide that you can choose from
- Transcript – an official transcript can ONLY be submitted by a school counselor.
- Payment for applying – can range from \$50 - \$100 per application. If a child is documented as having free/reduced lunch, a fee waiver REQUEST can be issued by the school counselor and student to the university. Please note that this is a request and is not guaranteed by the college. They have denied, in the past, some students' requests.

FAFSA

In order to get any type of financial aid, including student loans, a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) needs to be completed. PLEASE DO NOT PAY SOMEONE TO DO THIS! It is not a difficult application...just time consuming. To complete the FAFSA, go to <https://studentaid.gov/>



You must keep in mind the following:

- BOTH parent/guardian AND student need an account.
- BEFORE the FAFSA can be completed, parent/guardian AND student need to create separate FAS ID's. You will be provided with an AWESOME sheet that helps you create the ID. This process only takes about 5 minutes and will take 24-48 hours (about 2 days) to become active. – please see link for FSA ID worksheet - https://drive.google.com/file/d/1pvWTVz4VwwEDQ6yj4Exk_P9YQHvnQvtm/view?usp=sharing
- ⑩ FAFSA does not open until October 1, 2022. If you complete the application before this time, you will need to resubmit for consideration of financial aid for Fall 2023.
- The sooner you complete FAFSA, the more financial aid is available from colleges. It is better to do it sooner rather than later.
- If you completed your 2021 income tax returns online, you can easily link that from the IRS to FAFSA. There will be directions and prompts to help you through this. You will also be provided with an amazing article that will walk you step by step through the FAFSA



Key Things to remember when applying to colleges

1. DO NOT wait until the last minute to complete your application
2. If you are planning to attend college, you should apply to at least 3-4
3. You MUST meet all deadlines. Colleges do NOT accept late documentation
4. Please give your senior school counselor ample time to complete all necessary documentation.
5. Please give your teachers ample time to complete all necessary documentation and letters when asking for a recommendation.
6. You MUST complete the FAFSA – it is needed if you are going to ask for any type of financial assistance, INCLUDING LOANS

Graduation Requirements: - below are the requirements that are set by the Ohio Department of Education except for the last one.

- **English** – four credits
- **Math** – four credits – one must be Algebra 2 or equivalent
- **Science** – 3 credits – Physical Science, Biology & one upper level (Chemistry, Physics or Environmental Science)
- **Social Studies** – 3 credits – World History, US History and Government
- **Fine Art** – 1 credit
- **Electives** – 5 credits (one of those could be fine art which would satisfy both)
- **Physical Ed** - .50 credit
- **Health** - .50 credit
- **EOC** (End of Course Exam) Points – Earn a passing score on English 2 and Algebra.
- **Seals** – Must complete two seals – one or two State OR One State and one local
- **SEL Board of Education** – requires 10 hours of community service for every year that a student attends Brush High School – a copy of the Community Service Verification Sheet is on our SEL website.

- **Community Service** – Are due at the end of FIRST semester. Please turn in your hours to Ms. Myers as soon as possible. Community Service hours must be complete to participate in the commencement ceremony.
