MEET THE TEACHER NIGHT

Meet the Teacher Night will take place on Monday, August 16th from 6-8PM. We request, if possible, students with last names A-L attend from 6-7PM, and students with last names M-Z, participate from 7-8PM. Even though kindergarteners will not be assigned a teacher by the 16th, we encourage all of our families to show support, meet the staff, have a popsicle treat, interact with new families, and enjoy our first "icebreaker" of the year!

KINDERGARTEN READINESS ASSESSMENT (KRA)- AUG. 19 & 20

The KRA is a state required one-on-one test which evaluates students' literacy & language, math, motor development, and physical well-being. Our kindergarten teachers are excited about this early opportunity to proctor this assessment, as the information gleaned will allow our teachers to connect with the students in advance one-on-one, tailor their group and individual instruction, ensure an equitable balance of learners in the classroom, and prevent them from disrupting learning by having to proctor this assessment in the midst of the school year.

Please click the link below to schedule a 30-Minute Day/Time on either Aug. 19 or 20. Parents may choose to converse outside or remain in their car during the session. Students will not need to bring any materials for the KRA. After the assessment, students will leave the campus.

PHASE-IN DAYS (August 23 & Aug. 24)

FIRST OFFICIAL DAY OF KINDERGARTEN

The kindergarteners will report to school for their first official day on Wednesday, August 25th. Whether coming by bus, car, foot, or daycare transportation, students may arrive as early as 8:15AM. They will be ushered to the playground/blacktop area where their kindergarten teachers will be waiting for them.

Please recall that Wednesday, August 25th will also be an early release day. Dismissal will start at 2:15PM. (I apologize if I noted 2:30PM previously!)
