Meet & Greet Day-Monday, September 14th is our K-3 Meet & Greet Day, and we are looking forward to it! Teachers should have sent electronic invites via Sign Up Genius and/or Google Meet. If your schedule permits, sign up for a 10-minute time slot. Although this event occurs after the start of the school year, we still consider it to be of value. This will give us a brief opportunity to not only meet you before conferences, but it will also help us gauge how your child's first few days went. Please plan to share something positive about your child as well as if you foresee any barriers to the weekly schedule. **NOTE: The Meet & Greet will take the place of instruction on Monday, Sept. 14th. If you'd like to meet with a specific encore teacher, please email Mrs. Taylor with your request.**

ARCS Wednesdays- I apologize for any confusion that you or your child may have experienced this past Wednesday. **ARCS Wednesday** was a day strategically designed by our school district to provide time for teachers to do one or more of the following: **A**ssess students, **R**e-teach/Enrich, allow students to **C**atch Up on Assignments, and offer **S**ocial Emotional Resources. To accomplish this, the teachers will not teach their regular class schedule on ARCS Wednesdays; rather, they will make individual or small group appointments on a need basis. If the teacher does not request a specific appointment with your child, then please have your child complete online assignments and activities as directed by the teacher in a self-paced fashion.

Encore- Encore classes follow the Mon, Tues, Thurs, Friday schedule at 2pm. Due to the remote learning schedule, all students in a grade level will participate in encore class at one time. While this is exciting for the students to see all of their grade level peers, the drawback is that it can be cumbersome to host and manage several children at once. Please bear with us. We apologize if you've encountered inconveniences with joining and/or staying on the meetings.

Tech Issues-We apologize for the plethora of tech issues many of you have experienced. While we've increased our internal bandwidth and assessed our internet connections, we have yet to determine why some rooms have had sound problems and dropped calls, while other rooms have had minimal issues. Attendance- Attendance is recorded daily, and we must account for all students. To avoid phone calls from our secretary, please call the office to inform us if your child is ill, has an appointment, or if another situation is preventing your child's attendance. Please note that district letters will be issued regarding your child's repeated online absences according to House Bill 410. If there are extenuating circumstances, please relay this to the principal and/or your child's teacher.

Schoology Parent Access- Thank you to those who have set up a Parent Schoology account, to date. If you were unable to do so, no worries at this time! 12-Digit Access Codes were mailed, but if you did not receive a code, feel free to call Mrs. Kijinski, the school secretary. With your access code, you will be able to send quick messages to your child's teacher, check grades, see posted assignments, and view any announcements. At this juncture, there is little to no content available to see under the parent Schoology tab. There will be more at a later date. Your ability to access your parent account will not affect your child's ability to login to Schoology. K-1 teachers will be slowly introducing Schoology in the weeks to come.

Lunch/Breakfast Grab & Go Bags – For the entire first semester, **ANY** student under the age of 18 in your household is eligible to receive a **FREE Grab and Go** Breakfast/Lunch from 11-12pm.
