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**Important Paperwork Needed-**Please check your email and/or your US mail for the important paperwork and updated online Emergency Medical information needed, if you declared “In-Person” learning back in July. If you declared “Virtual” in July, and you are requesting to switch to school-based, then you must also complete these two steps. If you have firmly decided to keep your child at home and continue remote learning, this information is NOT needed at this time (although it would be great if you still updated the emergency info.) Please note the time sensitive nature of the required information: Friday, Oct. 30, by 2pm. More details will be forthcoming regarding the 2nd quarter.

**Parent-Teacher Conferences-** If you have not already done so, please sign up for Parent Conferences. Last week a link was provided with the digital sign up sheet from each of your child’s teachers. You may also schedule an appointment with any encore teacher. Conferences will be held from 5:30-8:30PM on Oct. 29 and Nov. 5th and from 8:30-3:30 on Oct. 30th.

**\*\*NOTE: There will be NO SCHOOL on Friday, Oct. 30th due to conferences.\*\***

**STAR Scores-** Soon, you will receive a notice regarding your child’s “On or Off Track” status in regards to the STAR reading diagnostic taken in September. The district has decided that scores at or below the 45th percentile will qualify students for a Reading Improvement and Monitoring Plan (RIMP). Should you receive such notification, please do not become discouraged, as this is baseline data. We will analyze your child’s areas of literacy weakness and plan instructional strategies to help him/her show future growth. We will monitor your child’s progress and set goals. These scores will be reviewed during conferences.
