Good afternoon

**Tuesday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, is SAT School Day at Brush High School.** This opportunity is only provided to 11<sup>th</sup> graders at no cost to you. Registration is not required and participation in this FREE. On Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup>, ONLY the junior class will be allowed on campus. All other students will work remotely at home on any assignments provided by their teachers. **Please read this email in its entirety as it contains important details related to the SAT School Day on Tuesday, April 27<sup>th</sup>.**

- Students will need to **arrive to Brush between 7:45-8:10 AM as testing begins promptly at 8:15 AM. Early arrival time encouraged** to allow for check-in, including temperature checks of 200+ students. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
- Face masks are required and must be worn covering the nose and mouth throughout the entire test day.
- **Students last name A-L** must enter through the Korb Field Cafeteria doors (off the parking lot) and will be directed to their room location after check-in.
- **Students last name M-Z** must enter at Welser and will be directed to their room location after check-in.
- **Students with approved testing accommodations** will test at **Southlyn** (1340 Professor Road). Southlyn is located at the corner of Professor and Farnhurst. It is the building that shares a parking lot with Memorial. **If your child was approved for accommodations, they will be notified to report to Southlyn between 7:45-8:10 AM as testing begins promptly at 8:15 AM on Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup>.**
- **STUDENTS WHO ARRIVE AFTER 8:15 AM WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO TEST AND WILL BE DIRECTED TO RETURN HOME. TIMELINESS TO TESTING IS IMPERATIVE.**
- Your child should have their school ID or state issued ID.
- **No cell phones** are permitted in the test site. If your child accesses their phone at any point during the four-hour testing window, their score **will be invalidated**, and they will be removed from the testing area.
- Students can have a snack and/or water as there is a break built into the testing session. Students need a simple snack **NOT** a full meal. Students should refrain from bringing unhealthy snacks or any other food source that tends to stain fingertips. We do not want any food smudges/particles on Chromebooks.
