



12th grade Meningococcal Requirement

The Ohio Department of Health has revised the School Immunization Requirements to include two (2) doses of Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine to be administered before a student enters the 12th grade.

The second (2nd dose) of MCV4 must be administered on or after the 16th birthday with at least (8) weeks between the first (1) and second (2) dose. If the first dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th birthday a second dose is NOT required. If a student is in the 12th grade and is 15 years of age or younger, only one (1) dose is required.
