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Goal #1 Teaching & Learning

We will develop a framework for teaching and learning that will increase student growth yearly

- 1. SEL will enhance curriculum and instruction by utilizing State and National Learning standards which are grounded in research, and are implemented by best instructional practices.
- 2. The SEL Schools will achieve annual increases in student growth through monitoring, responding, reporting/sharing instructional data with all stakeholders.
- 3. SEL will engage with the broader community to develop shared ownership over the teaching and learning of our youngest citizens and future leaders.
- 4. SEL Schools will equip their students with 21st Century Skills and produce students that are career Ready/College prepared.
- 5. Comprehensive Professional Development Plan.
- 6. Increase the use of Technology for the purpose of teaching and learning.





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Goal #2 Communications & Partnerships

We will develop a communication plan that will strengthen our internal and external communications and maximize our community partnerships

- 1. The SEL Schools will enhance its brand, building pride, purpose and visual flare.
- 2. The SEL Schools will enhance direct communications with the community.
- 3. The SEL Schools will create and maintain an active database of all stakeholders of the district and routinely update each of the lists.
- 4. The SEL Schools will develop Communications Collateral to have "On Hand".
- 5. The district will create meaningful partnerships with various segments of community.

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Goal #4 Facilities

We will develop and implement a plan to maximize our current resources and provide facilities that reflect the needs of students, staff and the community

- 1. Upgrade athletic facilities and grounds to accommodate the needs of the athletic teams and physical education classes.
 - a. Expansion of Korb Field amenities to accommodate the needs of Athletic teams.
 - b. Have a state of the art weight room.
 - c. Athletic game and practice fields that are adequately drained to accommodate the wear and tear of the season.
 - d. Athletic locker rooms at Memorial that are improved to meet the needs of all Jr. High Sports.
- 2. Playground surfaces that are free from potential hazards.
- 3. Create Master Plan for maximizing school building and land use.
 - a. Permanent Facilities Committee Formation to include staff, administration and community members.
 - b. Building replacement analysis and schedule.
- 4. Upgrade schools and classrooms to enhance educational programming and maintain value.
 - a. Mounted Interactive White Boards in 100% of classrooms.
 - b. Dedicated Science Lab in each of the K-3 buildings.
 - c. Improved Interior/Exterior finishes of buildings (Visible surfaces).
 - d. Improved Mechanical Systems of Buildings.
 - e. Improved Safety & Security of Buildings.
 - f. All schools have updated "ARCS" mascot in gyms, hallways and classrooms.
- 5. Look for creative ways to generate income or save expenses related to buildings and grounds.
 - a. Create a fee schedule for usage.
 - b. A cost savings through an energy conservation program.
