As we close out the month of March, we see spring break just around the corner. The third quarter ends on March 21st, the last day of school before spring break. Please be sure to sign up for parent teacher conferences. Spring parent teacher conferences are March 16th, 17th and 23rd. The email to sign up was sent out yesterday. I encourage you to contact your child's teacher directly if you have any questions or concerns regarding grades.

Students will take the Ohio State Tests in April. The ELA OSTs will be administered on April 10th and 11th. The Math OST will be administered on April 16th and 17th and the Science OST will be administered on 4/23 and 4/24 for 8th graders only. It is important that students arrive to school on time daily, but especially on testing days. Please do not schedule any appointments that will interrupt the test.

We want all students to finish the school year strong! Please continue to remind students to keep cell phones in their lockers, arrive to school daily on time, complete all assignments, charge chrome books at night, study and come ready to learn every day. Please check book bags to ensure the appropriate school supplies are included everyday.

The student expectations document as well as the Handbook are available on-line. Both should be reviewed at home often to ensure students understand the school rules. With the changing of the weather, please be sure your student is dressed appropriately for school daily. Students who are dressed inappropriately will be sent home.

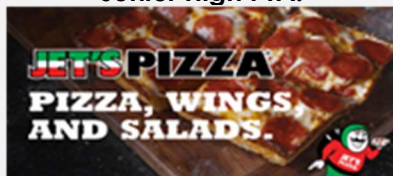

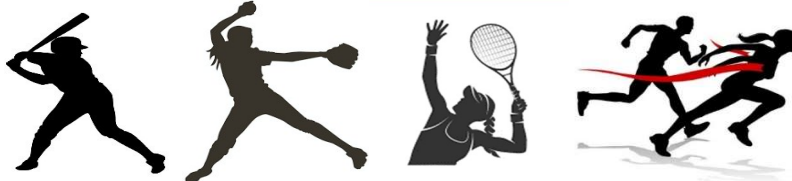
FOUNDERS'S DAY
