The following communication will touch base on some important items regarding 4th Quarter and AIR testing the week of 4/12 - 4/16:

4th Quarter Information:

I have included the 4th Quarter In-Person student letter to parents and the 4th Quarter Remote student letter to parents in this communication. Please review the attached letter that is applicable for your child.

As a reminder, if your child is returning to in-person for the start of the 4th Quarter, your child will need to arrive at the building by 7:45AM.

Please also know that the start of the 4th Quarter is also Part 2 of ELA testing for student who are M-Z. If you declared your child to return for the 4th Quarter on 4/12 but they are not scheduled to test that day, their first full day back in-person would be the start of their next testing session.

AIR Testing Reminders:

- Part 2 of ELA for students with last names M-Z is 4/12
- 7th Grade Math AIR Test will begin next week:
 - A-L Part 1 will take place on 4/13; Part 2 will take place on 4/14.
 - M-Z Part 1 will take place on 4/15; Part 2 will take place on 4/16.
- 8th Grade Science AIR Test will begin next week:
 - A-L Part 1 will take place on 4/13; Part 2 will take place on 4/14.
 - M-Z Part 1 will take place on 4/15; Part 2 will take place on 4/16
- Parents: If you are dropping your child off for AIR testing, they need to be here by 7:45AM and be dropped off at the backside of the school of Dorsh Rd.

Additional information to be aware of as students return for the 4th Quarter:

- All students must wear a mask at all time (except when eating).
- Students need to report to the building at 7:45AM. If your child is riding the bus, please contact transportation to verify their bus route location. If your child is a car rider, you will be dropping them off in the back of the building off of Dorsh Rd.
- Classes at MJH will be a mix of students in-person and students who are remote at the same time.
- Hallways will be labeled and identified for one-way traffic flow on each side of the hallway and social distancing guidelines will be posted throughout the building.
- Lockers will not be provided.
- Water bottles are permitted for students to bring with water filled from home.
- Car riders will have their temperatures taken at their respective vehicle
- Walkers will have their temperatures taken inside the building at the cafeteria.
