Students who opted for remote learning for the first semester will continue their current online learning schedule for the remainder of the 2nd quarter. The 3rd Quarter does not start until February 1st. If you chose IN-PERSON or REMOTE Learning on your recent 3rd Quarter Declaration, you will receive more information and details as that date approaches.

AM CAR Line starts in the small playground parking lot, and the overflow lines up on Meadow Wood. Please do not block residential driveways, intersections, or crosswalks. Stay 30 feet behind the stop sign. Students must get a temperature check by a staff member and properly wear a mask before exiting the car on the passenger side.

2PM Car Line Dismissal for Grades K-1 occurs in the small playground parking lot. Please follow the above traffic procedures. Display the student's name placard on your dashboard. Please confirm your child's dismissal plan (bus, car, walk home with parent, aftercare) with his/her teacher prior to Monday.

Grades 2-3 car riders (including younger siblings) will be dismissed in the front oval at 2pm after the buses have left the premises.

Walkers will be released to their parents from the flagpole door at 2pm.
